The Department of Ecosystems and Environment, Faculty of Agriculture and Forest Engineering at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile (PUC) is now seeking application for a 12-months tenure track position at the assistant or associate professor rank in HYDROLOGY AND WATERSHED MANAGEMENT.

The successful applicant will join a multidisciplinary research group working on natural resources and global environmental change.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in a relevant field (Ecology, Hydrology, Agronomy, Soil science, Forestry). Excellent oral and written communication skills. Experience in teaching and a strong knowledge of water resources management are expected. Teaching responsibilities include new courses at the undergraduate and graduate level. The candidate should conduct basic and applied research in water resources and watershed management, incorporating sustainable practices and planning decisions in a local and regional level. Results should be published in scientific journals. Graduate student advising and cooperative work with other faculty members are expected. It is expected that the candidate will join the Faculty and teach a course in Watershed Modeling and Management in August 2011.

Candidates should submit their resumes and two letters of recommendation as well as a cover letter indicating why they feel they are a good fit for the position at PUC, and a statement of teaching and research interests.
